

**SYLLABUS FOR COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION FOR RECRUITMENT
TO THE POST OF SUB INSPECTOR POLICE (EX SERVICE MEN) COMB. COMP.
EXAMINATION, 2008**

The competitive examination shall include the following papers and each paper shall carry 200 marks: -

SCOPE OF THE PAPERS:

Paper I – GENERAL HINDI (सामान्य हिन्दी) : इस पत्र का उद्देश्य अभ्यर्थी की भाषा – विषयक बोध क्षमता तथा उसके विचारों की सही, स्पष्ट एवं प्रभावपूर्ण अभिव्यक्ति की परख करना है ।

भाग 'अ' – 50 अंक

भाषा-ज्ञान :

1. संधि एवं संधि विच्छेद : दिये गये शब्दों में संधि करना और संधि विच्छेद करना ।
2. समास : दिये गये शब्दों से सामासिक पदों की रचना और समास विग्रह करना ।
3. उपसर्ग : उपसर्गों का सामान्य ज्ञान और उनके संयोग से शब्दों की संरचना और शब्दों में विद्यमान उपसर्गों को पृथक् करना ।
4. प्रत्यय : प्रत्ययों का सामान्य ज्ञान और उनके संयोग से शब्दों की संरचना और शब्दों में विद्यमान प्रत्ययों को पृथक् करना ।
5. पर्यायवाची तथा विलोम शब्द

7. एक वाक्यांश के लिए एक सार्थक शब्द
8. शब्द – शुद्धि (दिये हुए अशुद्ध शब्दों को शुद्ध रूप में लिखना)
9. वाक्य – शुद्धि (वर्तनी सम्बन्धी अशुद्धियों से रहित विभिन्न व्याकरणित अशुद्धियों वाले वाक्य को शुद्ध करना)
10. मुहावरे (वाक्यों में केवल सार्थक प्रयोग अपेक्षित है)
11. लोकोक्तियां (वाक्यों में केवल सार्थक प्रयोग अपेक्षित है)
12. पारिभाषिक शब्दावली (प्रशासन से सम्बन्धित अंग्रेजी शब्दों के समानार्थक हिन्दी शब्द)

1. संक्षिप्तीकरण : गद्यावतरण का उचित शीर्षक एवं एक – तिहाई शब्दों का संक्षिप्तीकरण तथा गद्यावतरण पर प्रश्न
2. वृद्धिकरण : किसी सूक्ति, प्रसिद्ध कथन आदि का भाव – विस्तार
3. पत्रा – लेखन : व्यावसायिक एवं कार्यालयिक पत्रा

Paper – II : GENERAL KNOWLEDGE & GENERAL SCIENCE
(OBJECTIVE TYPE)

Duration: 3 Hours

Max. Marks : 200

1. Current affairs & events :- Knowledge of important events that have happened in India during the past 2 years. India's system of Government. Important measures of Legislation whether undertaken by the Parliament of Rajasthan state Legislature question of India's Policy relating to foreign affairs. World events of inter-national importance both Indian and Foreign sports and other cultural activities of outstanding importance.
2. General Science:-
 - 1 SCIENCE: Question set will test everyday of science Knowledge and general awareness of the candidate on scientific aspects as may be expected of an educated person who has not made any regular study of any specific science subject.
 - 2 GENERAL:
 - (a) Elementary knowledge of Human body and its important organs.
 - (b) Names and uses of common animals, trees, plants, flowers, birds and minerals.
 - (c) Common epidemic, their causes, means of prevention and cure.

Note: The approach in science subject should be general and should not be technical & /or specialized. The standard of the papers will be that of a Degree Examination.

IMPORTANT

Candidates, who obtain 36 % of marks in each paper and 40% in the aggregate, shall be deemed to have passed the qualifying examination. Relaxation upto 5 marks will be available to candidates belonging the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in each paper and in the aggregate.

Candidates who are declared successful in the written examination shall be required to appear before a Physical efficiency Board for physical efficiency test. The physical efficiency test would be vigorous as laid down by the Director General of Police to adjudge suitability of the candidate. The physical efficiency test shall carry 100 marks and the candidates who secure 50% marks therein, shall be eligible for selection.

Candidates who are declared successful in the written test and in the physical efficiency test shall be eligible for an aptitude test and interview which shall carry 50 marks. Provided that the number of candidates called for aptitude test and interview shall be restricted to three times the number of vacancies on the basis of merit based on the aggregate marks obtained both in the written and in the physical efficiency test (except in the case of scheduled castes and scheduled tribes candidates who shall be eligible for interview in excess of the prescribed limit if they have qualified in the written examination and the physical efficiency test.)

The aptitude test and interview shall be held by a Recruitment Board. The Recruitment Board shall award marks to each candidate in respect of suitability to the post, taking into consideration personality, address, tact, behavior, specialized training, aptitude for the post, judgement, leadership and knowledge of Rajasthan Culture. The marks so awarded shall be added to the marks obtained in the written test by each such candidate. Candidates holding Degree or Diploma in criminology or N.C.C. "C" Certificate or who have offered Police Administration as one of the papers for the degree examination may be given weight.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Commission shall not recommend candidates, who have secured less than 36% marks in interview and 45% marks in aggregate.

Provided that the Commission may recommend women candidates, candidates belonging to the Other Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, who though failing to obtain the minimum marks, are declared by the Board to be suitable for appointment to the service with due regard to the maintenance of efficiency of administration, if the candidates secure 30% marks in interview and 40% marks in the aggregates.
