

**PUNISHMENT FOR INSOLENT BEHAIOUR/DISORDERLY
CONDUCT/USING OR ATTEMPTING TO USE
UNFAIRMEANS DURING THE COURSE OF
EXAMINATION**

1. NATURE OF CASES IN WHICH A CANDIDATE'S THAT EXAMINATION CAN BE CENCELLED:
 - (i) Disobeying the instructions of the Supdt./Addl. Supdt./Dy. Supdt./Invigilator or member of Flying Squad.
 - (ii) Talking within examination centre campus (Hall, urinals etc.) during the course of examination.
 - (iii) Suppressing information demanded in examination form.
 - (iv) Leaving examination hall in violation of rules/instructions of invigilator.

2. NATURE OF CASES IN WHICH A CANDIDATE CAN BE DEBARRED FOR APPEARING IN ANY EXAMINATION OF COMMISSION FOR NEXT ONE YEAR IN ADDITION TO CANCELLATION OF THAT EXAMINATION :
 - (i) Candidate who is found in examination centre in possession of some materials (including material written on wall/furniture near the candidate/body/cloths of candidate) related to subject which can be used in that subject but which has not been used.
 - (ii) Attempting to copy from other candidate's answer book.

3. CASES IN WHICH A CANDIDATE CAN BE DEBARRED FOR APPEARING IN ANY EXAMINATION OF COMMISSION FOR NEXT TWO YEARS IN ADDITION TO CANCELLATION OF THAT EXAINATION :
 - (i) Tempering with his own answer book in any way.
 - (ii) The candidate is found in possession of incrimination material (as described under 2(i) and has used the material for answering the examination paper.
 - (iii) Copying from the answer book of other candidate.

4. CASES INWHICH A CANDIDTE CAN BE DEBARRED FOR APPEARING IN ANY EXAMINATION OF COMMISSION FOR NEXT THREE YEARS IN ADDITION TO CANCELLATION OF THAT EXAMINATION :
 - (i) Runs away with his own answer book.
 - (ii) Refusing to give declaration in prescribed form.
 - (iii) Writing of other examinee's Roll No. on answer book.
 - (iv) Marking identification marks in the answer book.

5. CASES WHICH A CANDIDATE CAN BE DEBARRED FOR APPEARING INANY EXAMINATION OF COMMISSION FOR NEXT FIVE YEARS IN ADDITION TO CANCELLATION OF THAT EXAMINATION :
 - (i) Attempting to destroy/destroying evidence of copying.
 - (ii) Threatening, intimidating or misbehaviouring with Supdt./Add. Supdt./Dy. Supdt./Invigilator or members of Flying squad in connection with examination work before, during and after examination.
 - (iii) Taking help of any outside person in answering question paper.
 - (iv) Providing false information in examination form.
 - (v) Attempting to influence any person connected with examination for favour.

6. CASES WHICH A CANDIDATE CAN BE DEBARRED FOR APPEARING IN ANY EXAMINATION OF COMMISSION FOR NEXT WHOLE LIFE IN ADDITION TO CANCELLATION OF THAT EXAMINATION :
 - (i) Submitting forged documents.
 - (ii) Impersonation i.e. sending other person to appear in examination on his behalf.
 - (iii) Disrupting conduct of examination or attempting to do so.
 - (iv) Tempering with the secrecy of the examination in any form or attempting to do so.
 - (v) Attempting to put pressure on the Commission/Selection board for favour.
 - (vi) Bringing in examination Centre any weapon or similar objects.
 - (vii) Physically mishandling assaulting Centre Supdt. or any other person connected with examination work.
